There will be one 6 week session at Mears Marina this summer. June 22 – July 31st. The session is six consecutive weeks. Monday – Friday mornings or evenings for 10 minutes each lesson. Yes, that is 5 days a week. 10 minutes per day, for 6 consecutive weeks. Each lesson is taught by Certified ISR Instructor, Tracey Hurst. The cost of the session is \$100 per week in addition to the National Registration fee of \$105 per child. The Registration Fee is non-refundable. Space is limited and children are accepted upon completion and approval from the ISR national registration evaluation team (RET) and are limited to Members only at the Mears location. Should your child be unable to participate in the designated session, or you know you will have to miss some classes due to prior commitments, every effort will be made to accommodate you after the session ends on July 31st for make-up classes.

Please keep in mind when securing your timeslot, ISR protocol requires the student, not to eat or drink anything 2 hours prior to their lesson to ensure a safe and effective lesson.
